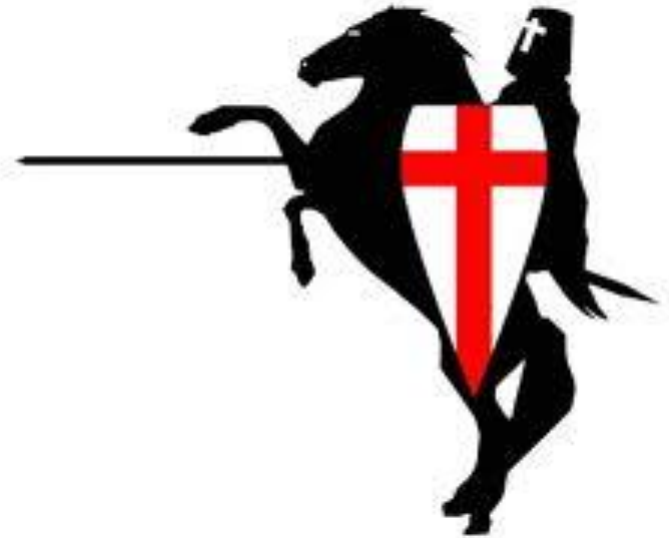

1. Rounds: St.George, Albion, Windsor, Short & Junior Windsor's
2. Medals awarded to individuals :- **Recurve Men:** 1st & 2nd
Recurve Ladies: 1st & 2nd **Compound Men:** 1st & 2nd
Compound Women: 1st & 2nd **Longbow Men:** 1st & 2nd **Longbow Ladies:** 1st & 2nd (Barebow & Juniors dependent on entry)
Team trophy:- Recurve & Compound to include at least one lady and or junior, team made up of best three archers from your club.
Winners must have shot the round appropriate to age.
3. Shooting will be under GNAS rules and GNAS dress regulations **do not** have to be conformed to.
4. No entries will be accepted on the day and no substitutes will be allowed.
