Awards

Seniors: Lady and Gent: Recurve, Compound and Longbow 1st, 2nd and 3rd. Recurve and Compound Teams.

Juniors: Awards for all bow disciplines will be made according to entries in age groupings and gender.

All awards, except prizes and medals, will be held for one year or to the next Tournament, whichever is sooner and remain the property of Chorley Bowmen.

An archer may take only one prize except in the case of the team awards.

Regulations

Entries will only be accepted from members of GNAS and FITA affiliated societies and membership cards must be produced at registration.

Juniors will be classed as any entrant below the age of 18 and can enter any of the rounds of a higher classification than that for their age group.

No entries will be taken without the entry form being submitted and accompanied by the correct entry fee.

Refunds will not be made after closing date and substitutes will be allowed.

A raffle will be held at the end of the shoot before the awards ceremony.

In view of the provisions of the GNAS Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the tournament organiser.

Directions from the North Leave the M61 at junction 8 and follow signs to Chorley on the A6. Pass B & Q, McDonalds, Chorley Train Station and Morrisons and follow the A6 towards Bolton. Pass the Yarrow Bridge Hotel on the left and at the second set of Traffic Lights take the right turn into A5106 Wigan Lane towards Wigan. Wigan Lane Playing fields are approx. 1 mile away on the right

Directions from the South Leave the M6 at junction 27 and take the A5209 towards Standish and Wigan. At the cross roads continue straight on towards Haigh and Chorley on the B5239. Pass under the railway bridge and at the mini roundabout turn left onto the A5106. Wigan Lane Playing fields are approx. 3 miles away on the left.
