REGULATIONS

1. Shooting will be under WA and Archery GB rules.
2. Archers **MUST** conform to Archery GB dress regulations (those not complying will not be allowed to shoot).
3. The Target List will be available on the LAA Website after the closing date.
4. Crossbows, professional archers and substitutes are not allowed.
5. Entries on the day are **NOT** allowed.
6. An archer may take only one prize each day except in the case of Gold or Team awards.
7. Record Status Shoots are liable to drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply; a refusal will be treated as a positive result.
8. Entries will **NOT** be accepted without payment.
9. Archers must sign their entry form, giving consent to a drug test, if required. A Parent or Guardian must sign for junior archers.
10. Proof of Archery GB membership will be requested at registration.
11. The Association will not be responsible for damage to equipment.

12. No all-carbon arrows for York/Hereford rounds.

13. In view of provisions of the Archery GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at the tournament must register with the tournament organiser.

JUNIORS: Wishing to enter this event, please be advised, that there will only be the senior distances available only, as a separate tournament for juniors is provided by LAA.

FACILITIES

1. Refreshments will be available on site on both days.
2. Car parking is available at the venue and ground level access to toilets.
3. Disabled archers will be allocated parking spaces and there's full disabled access to the club building.

TEAM AWARDS

COMPOUND	The PHILLIPS SHIELD and medals for the highest aggregate score by a local compound team of three archers (incl at least one lady or junior) from an LAA club.
FAMILY TROPHY (COMPOUND)	The COMPOUND VASE for the highest score from two Lancashire archers with compound bows, who are parent and child, married couple or partners who live at the same permanent address.
FAMILY TROPHY (RECURVE)	The WILLIAMSON trophy for the highest score from two Lancashire archers with recurve bows, who are parent and child, married couple or partners living at the same permanent address
VETERAN	The PETER PRICE CUP and medal for the Local Veteran Champion (recurve) – aged over 55.
	The JEAN HUGHES MEMORIAL CUP for the Local Veteran Champion (compound) – aged over 55.
