## Eccles Double WA 70m World Record Status Tournament (Tier 3 Ranking Event)

Tournament Organiser: Mark Leach

- **Sunday 17th May 2019**
- **World Record Status (confirmed) Double WA 70m:** 12 dozen arrows at 70 metres, 122cm face, 10 zone scoring. Four archers per boss. Two detail shooting: mixed lady/gent. Faces to be marked. There will be 'double scoring'. WA timing (10 sec & 4 min) under control of a National Judge. Shooting will be controlled by lights.
- Morning session: Equipment check will start at 9:00am, assembly at 9:30, two ends of practice and then straight into the competition. The afternoon session will follow lunch. There will be no practice, except for archers only shooting the afternoon session.
- Lady/Lord Paramount: TBC
- Judges: Lorraine Morris (J-in-C) & Philip Morris plus other(s) (TBC).
- Shooting will be under Archery GB/GNAS rules. All entrants must be members of Archery GB or a World Archery affiliated organisation. Dress regulations must be conformed to.
- The competitors at this record status shoot will be liable for drug testing and those approached to give samples must comply; if they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Juniors must have a parent or guardian sign the entry form to signify consent for their child being tested if approached.
- In line with Archery GB Child and Vulnerable Adults Protection Policy, anyone wishing to take photographs or video at the competition must register with the organiser.
- AGB GDPR advice: When you enter competitions, the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published. Shared data may include: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.
- Medals L/G x RC/Comp/LB/BB & mixed team-of-three shooting 70m will be awarded at the end of the shoot for the double round, depending upon entries. The team-of-three awards will be calculated against the equivalent bowman handicap.
- There will be a most improved award calculated over the two rounds... and the famous Eccles Wooden Spoon *for the most deteriorated archer over the two rounds.*
- Prepayment by cheque is essential to confirm a place. Please make these made payable to Eccles Archery Club and send to **Mark Leach, 176 Park Lane, Whitefield, Manchester M45 7QL**

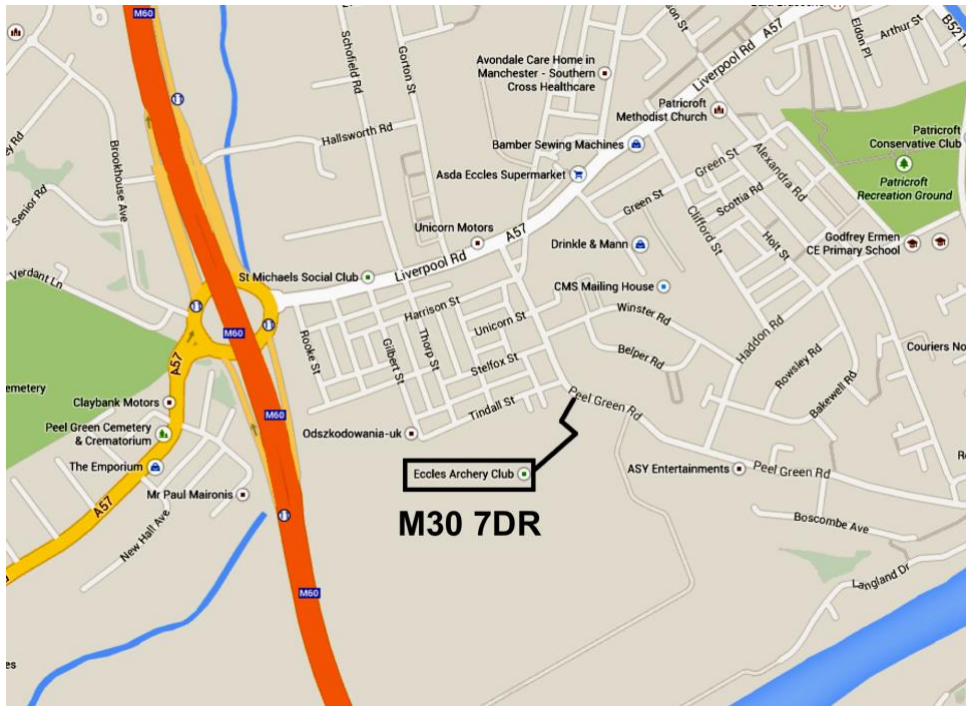
